Responsibilities for labor relations representative

- Conducts wage and benefit reviews for non-union locations
- Evaluate pre-arbitration grievances to determine if the files are complete and whether there is room for resolution, Takes necessary steps to collect & log information/documentation
- Attend pre-arbitration meetings to circumvent arbitration
- Proactively identify labor relations issues and themes based on key labor metrics
- Advises management regarding craft employee issues and interprets work rules, pay issues
- Supports the labor relations management in the program development of assigned subject expertise, discipline, issue resolution, unemployment compensation, affirmative action plan and audit preparation
- Serves as project lead in the development of processes and oversight to departmental roles that impact the organization's federal compliance capability
- Serves as lead in the facilitation of the unemployment compensation claims and hearing process
- Serves as secondary support to labor relations roles and responsibilities as needed
- Prioritizes work, effectively handles multiple tasks simultaneously, takes initiative, possesses sound reasoning and problem solving skills, functions as a team member works independently, develops and conducts presentations
