Responsibilities for laboratory scientist

- Perform viral neutralization assays
- Transposes data into tabular form of simple graphs
- Provides prompt, professional, and courteous customer service regarding routine inquires
- Develop, optimize, implement and maintain complex laboratory automation platforms
- Conduct screening campaigns on laboratory automation systems
- Analyze and review experiment data, integrate results in data management system
