Responsibilities for land surveyor

- Have good influencing and negotiating skills
- Be fully competent at using the appropriate Company IT systems and Office software
- Responding to all RFIs issued by the contractor within the time limits established by the Resident Engineers and Senior Highway Surveyor
- Perform land surveys
- Performing record research, construction stakeout, and boundary, topographic, transportation and utility surveys utilizing total stations and data collectors
- Review information from survey teams regarding measurement of distances, directions, angles between points and elevation of points, lines, and contours on, above, and below the earth's surface
- Plan field work & select known survey reference points
- Determine the precise location of important features in the survey area
- Research legal records, look for evidence of previous boundaries, and analyze the data to determine the location of boundary lines
- Record the results of surveys and verify accuracy of data

Qualifications for land surveyor

- You will be expected to travel throughout the UK and be prepared to work away from home including at weekends and on night shifts
- Ability to handle the physical aspects of required field work

- Ensure project goals/objectives are met within prescribed timeframe and funding parameters
- Assist in developing and writing proposals, define scopes of work and cost/bid estimates
- Perform mapping related research, boundary analysis, calculations, exhibits, and legal descriptions for a variety of land development and public works related projects from small infill developments to large master-planned communities and public related improvement projects throughout Arizona
