Responsibilities for land surveyor

- Prepare sketches to support the field work
- Perform survey work under the direction and guidance of the Senior Surveyor
- Supervising and coordinating the activities of Site staff for whom responsible and keeping them informed on matters which may influence their work
- Checking regularly the primary survey control beaconing and the setting out of all parts of the Permanent Works, before construction, and the line and level, after construction
- Ensuring prompt responses when the Contractor has called for inspections of setting out

- Observing the performance of the finished works including recording movements and settlements
