Responsibilities for lead business systems analyst

- Researching and analysing the country-level specifics needed for integration for each country and vendor (scope will increase over time)
- Writing functional specifications and other documentation as needed (Interface Mapping, GAP Analysis, Functional Analysis, Technical Specs)
- Coordinating the release of new and enhanced functionality
- Working closely with the other GVS CSMs and with GVS Country Solution Architect (GVS CSA) to ensure the appropriate template details are analysed, built, tested, and documented
- Review technical specifications, user publications, and other product-related documentation for correctness, content, and clarity
- Lead small and large projects and act as the primary point of contact between the technical areas

- Act as a project manager to support schedule creation and project management
