Responsibilities for lead trainer

- Plan, provide and execute training, and lead training teams for MILES 2000, Precision Gunnery System (PGS), AIMTESTI, Improvised Explosive Device Effects Simulator (IEDES), Laser Marksmanship Training System (LMTS), Laser Convoy Counter-Ambush Training System (LCCATS), and other training devices available at the TSC
- Provide instruction and initial training to customers in proper use of the training devices
- Upon 72 hours advance notice, provide Simulations Training Team assistance for requesting units at designated training locations
- Work with mentors to align training and understanding of the CIED/EOD mission
- Deliver and facilitate the standard onsite
- Establish and maintain online forums/communities for learners/practitioners to share questions, knowledge and best practices
- Manage and maintain the internal Change Management Trainer pool
- Where possible, coach learners in change management projects
- Align learning technique to learners' styles and preferences
- Stimulate learner motivation and encourage participation

Qualifications for lead trainer

- Must be highly proficient in reading and using a map, giving and accepting directions in topographical terms, and in communicating map information
