Responsibilities for lead trainer

- Modify programs as needed
- Provide effective training materials utilizing a variety of media
- Coach others involved in training efforts, providing effective growth and development opportunities
- Maintain property communications such as bulletin boards and newsletters to ensure employees have knowledge of property events and general information
- Plan and organize training for employees with regards to OSHA Regulations, Hazmat, new hire orientation, and OTJ training
- Work with Operations Supervisors with the re-evaluation of employees and assist in the operations process
