- Perform and/or supervise acquisition of materials, original and copy cataloging, authority control, and online catalog database maintenance
- Oversee interlibrary loan functions and serials and government publications acquisitions and control
- Supervise and evaluate unit staff and determine workflow assignments and priorities
- Provide leadership in planning, developing, implementing, and monitoring of acquisitions and collection development policies and protocols
- Participate in the development, implementation, monitoring, and reporting of the library materials budget
- Develop and maintain relations with information resource vendors, and monitor and assess vendor performance
- Serve as liaison to assigned academic departments, providing instruction, outreach, and collection development services

- Experience consulting and working with faculty/instructors, especially on course, tutorial, or assignment design, or in developing educational programs
