Responsibilities for lift operations

- The daily operation of their assigned ski/bike lift and related facilities
- Updating labor report for Managers approval
- Training presentation and training documentation organization
- Running inter-departmental competitions
- Picking up or dropping off documents/items while traveling from lift to lift on skis/snowboard
- Auditing and filing of Lift Operation documents
- Assist with administrative duties such as correspondence, meeting minutes, emailing, copying, faxing, scheduling of meetings, returning phone calls and other administrative support as required
- Contribute to team effort by participating in job sharing, assuming responsibility for the cleanliness of the office and safety of guests and employees
- Coach employees on proper lift operation procedures including safety protocols, ramp maintenance, guest service
- Promote guest service standards compliance and operational efficiency model positive guest service at all times

Qualifications for lift operations

- Must have a high work ethic
- You must provide your own ski or ride gear
- Must be able to ski or ride at level 7 (test required)

- Must be able to sit, stand, walk, stoop/kneel/crouch for up to 2/3's or more of work day
- Must be able to move human body from a prone position to an upright position
