Responsibilities for line mechanic

- Operate equipment to meet production needs of team
- Removing and installing Line Replacement Units (LRU's) and engine components repair work
- Incorporate modifications and inspecting / evaluating engine components
- Providing assistance to troubleshoot and resolve engine and aircraft system malfunctions
- Collecting and reporting engine-related information
- Troubleshoots and diagnoses equipment malfunctions and makes repairs or adjustments based on that diagnosis by using repair parts, by correcting existing parts, or by innovation to select substitute parts
- Disconnects and reconnects services to repaired assemblies
- Moves material, equipment and machinery using standard methods of lifting, rigging, hoisting, blocking skidding and rolling
- Able to perform troubleshooting procedures to identify the root cause of defects, equipment/utility failures and programmable logic controller error
- Proficient at use of PC for troubleshooting of PLC based equipment
