Responsibilities for logistics management specialist

- Develop clear resource requirements in support of strategic planning and project execution
- Plan for contractor support requirements, develop contract documentation and execute TPOC requirements as assigned
- Provide a standardized process and set of metrics to measure and track the performance of Theory of Constraints (TOC) integrated projects and the outcomes of the efforts
- Improve program and Fleet support through objective analysis, including the early identification of opportunities to sustain readiness at reduced costs
- Develop procedures, processes and measures needed to generate, sustain, substantiate and report progress against project requirements, acquisition strategies, contracting strategies, implementation/fielding plans, and sustainment plans
- Coordinate with AIR 6.7, 6.7 TD, 6.7.2 and other leadership, as necessary, on a continuing basis to ensure all programmatic direction and tasking is appropriately identified and aligned, tasking is assigned and funded, programmatic deficiencies and risks to the projects are understood, and optimal visibility of projects is institutionalized
- Informs the chain of command of potential challenges, and situations that affect cost, schedule, performance and risks for TOC projects
- Serve as Chief Logistics Management for the National Museum of Health and Medicine and supervise by directing, developing, implementing and

- Prepare statements and oversee conduct and development of Market Research, Statements of Work, Performance Work Statements, and other preacquisition documentation
