Responsibilities for MAINT tech

- Certified Outage Technical Engineer" (COTE) qualifies the impact of the outage and restores the service efficiently and within the required timeframe
- Use the knowledge management tool by searching/creating/updating articles
- Performs duties as specified in the Maintenance, Quality Control, Safety, and other Programme Plans, in Maintenance Training Center (MTC) Standard Operating Procedures (SOP)
- Regularly Stand
- Frequently Walk
- Occasionally Sit
- Determines extent of repairs needed
- Performs routine preventative maintenance tasks such as adjusting conveyor chains, adding oil to drives, changing belts, filling equipment lubricators
- Performs non-routine maintenance repairs on equipment such as motor brake adjustment, coupling alignment checks and drive train adjustments
- Troubleshoots and repairs production lines to include replacement of micro-switches, sequencing correction on conveyors, restoration of power outages
