Responsibilities for maintenance coordinator

- Assure completion of assigned maintenance and repair activities by monitoring work progress through RMS (Verisae) and providing corrections of any deficiencies as necessary, redirect work efforts to meet critical and/or necessary work requirements, and make recommendations on reallocating resources to meet assigned completion targets
- Review and approve invoices for area of responsibility through the use of the RMS (Verisae) system
- Request purchase orders in applicable situations to align with policies
- Contribute to the overall success of Retail Maintenance Services by performing other essential duties and responsibilities as assigned
- Asset management through the maintenance work center management system (INFOR EAM)
- Track LOE costs by reconciling invoices to work tickets, GPS sheets and standard pricing and time-per-job trends
- Release scheduled work orders for preventative maintenance and send the report to the contractor who will do the work
- Close the open work orders, troubleshoot any errors, and create any corrective work orders initiated from the initial work done
- Responsible for handling preventive maintenance
- Ensure that spills and other mishaps are cleaned up properly

Qualifications for maintenance coordinator

- Ability to drive a van or truck is desirable
- Two or more years' experience in a customer centric business environment with administrative responsibility, preferably in real estate and/or property management
- Basic understanding of Landlord / Tenant relationships, familiarity with building engineer methodologies, engagements
- Strong interpersonal communication, negotiation and analytical skills
- Must be able to utilize PPE when necessary
