Responsibilities for manager analyst

- Ensure that all contracts are reviewed for revenue recognition compliance in accordance with US GAAP (Topic 605, esp

- Oversee the timely setup of contracts in the PeopleSoft "Contracts Module" for proper revenue/cost recognition under the Company's revenue/expense accounting policy
