Responsibilities for manager, demand planning

- Maintains a yearly profit plan forecast and monthly rolling forecasts within an 18 month forecasting horizon
- Own the quarterly demand review process for the region by providing the data and market specific knowledge
- Develop yourself, people and processes and expand use of technology
- Collaborate with other demand planner in other regions to build a cross regional excellence in processes
- Ensure adherence to Demand Planning Key Performance Indicators
- Ensure adherence to Inventory Key Performance Indicators (Days Cover
- Hire, train and mentor new planners
- Analyze performance data (including Point of Sale (POS), shipments, and inventory) to identify and understand trends to determine the future impact to the forecast
- Communicate the monthly channel forecast to all stakeholders using standard communication tools and reports
