Responsibilities for manager pharmacy

- Provides support and/or oversight for all clinical aspects of the pharmacy benefit, including elements such as drug formularies, clinical programs, medication adherence initiatives and medication therapy management
- Works with the rest of the Pharmacy team to oversee Pharmacy Operations and monitor PBM (Pharmacy Benefit Manager) data and activities
- Manage a team of pharmacy technicians and their daily activities
- Responsible for member and provider communications
- Experience assessing impact due to regulation changes
- Experience maintaining member and provider materials related to medication adherence and pharmacy quality programs
- Directs the daily activities of the professional and supportive staff in the medication use process
- Facilitates the preparation of the outpatient pharmacy schedule and monitors daily staff schedules and needs for technicians and pharmacists adjustments based on current workflow patterns, job responsibilities, staffing levels, staffing mix, and with all other pertinent operational issues to identify and to deal effectively integrate and continuously improve systems in a cost effective manner
- In conjunction with the Director of Pharmacy, is responsible for maintaining required State and Federal pharmacy licenses and registrations and in assuring that pharmacy operations are conducted in accordance with outpatient pharmacy service standard and objectives, regulatory, legal and

- Oversees outpatient pharmacy purchasing activities for all drugs and supplies and corresponding budget adherence and for review, development and implementation of plans to continually evaluate and revise purchasing methods
