Responsibilities for mechanical inspector

- Conduct tests with appropriate NDE Technique as needed
- Creates and uses equipment set-ups, such as micrometers, gauges, calipers, indicators, comparator, and CMM, to perform complex inspection on productive parts, records results in SAP
- Accurately read and comprehend documentation relating to material/production
- Inspection of material per customer specifications for workmanship, dimensions, tolerances and usability, using FIFO System
- Release accepted material to Stock Room, within three days of receipt
- Creates own and reviews Quality Inspection Records (QIR) of lower level inspectors
- Performs visual and dimensional checking of production parts at supplier's facility per source inspection requirements
- Assists Quality team with follow-up of open issues with suppliers and processors
- Attends and participates in Production In-Process Improvement Team as directed
- Operate CMM in order to make precise measurements of component or assembled parts

Qualifications for mechanical inspector

- Able to work under extreme time factors and conditions especially during shut down and TAR

- Good proficiency of English, both spoken and written
- Minimum of 8 years experience in the industrial and as an inspector or craftsman in related manufacturing or construction along with the level I education requirements
- Minimum of 5 years experience of Field Quality Assurance/Control experience in addition to testing and application experience for a broad range of Field Quality Assurance/Control disciplines
- Prior certification as a Level II NDE Examiner (RTI, MT, PT, UT), and API -510 or AWS CWI is mandatory
