Responsibilities for med technologist

- Demonstrates the knowledge and theory of applicable Clinical Laboratory Medicine in order to produce required measure of accuracy
- Coordinates performance of system checks and monitors. Performs summaries with action plans and follow up when required
- Interacts with regulatory inspectors, auditors, and assessors as necessary
- Keeps abreast of FACT, NYS, FDA and CAP regulations and acts to implement compliance, change and/or corrective action
- Evaluates, writes performance appraisals, counsels and provides feedback for the SCP Medical Technologists
- Manages maintenance, troubleshooting and minor repair of equipment. Interacts with Clinical Engineering and outside vendors for major repairs and preventative maintenance. Coordinates with the QA Specialist to document repairs
- Reviews serologic work, verifying problem patient records
- Directs advanced serological work for difficult problem resolution
- Maintains a detailed procedure manual, evaluating and implementing new techniques
- Manages inventory of supplies
