Responsibilities for medical equipment technician

- Demonstrate working knowledge of the department's inventory and receiving modules by inspecting and verifying the accuracy of all inbound/outbound equipment
- Ensure returned product, equipment totes, and pallets are picked up and returned daily to the designated areas in warehouse
- Manage all medical equipment to ensure proper maintenance by performing quality control checks, preventative maintenance, cleaning/sterilization techniques, and delivery/pickup preparation when servicing facilities
- Manage dispatch operations for the dispatch of medical specialty equipment, arrange transportation of specialty equipment between hospitals and track inventory closely

Qualifications for medical equipment technician
