Responsibilities for medical equipment technician

- Maintain competency on equipment, USDOT hazardous materials compliance, and company policy and procedures
- Implement USDOT requirements for delivery of hazardous materials transportation and FDA requirements for the distribution and tracking of medical oxygen
- Provides cost effective equipment inspection, maintenance, calibration and repair service on general biomedical equipment
- Inspects, cleans and tests general biomedical equipment for functionality, following approved written procedures
- Assists in patient handling equipment training as needed
- Adheres to the Medical Equipment Management Plan (MEMP), including all regulatory agency compliances and other applicable policies and procedures
- Cleans, delivers, sets up, and picks up home medical equipment
- Works with patients, instructing on operation of equipment
- Works with little supervision to uphold and ensure quality care
- Routine and Reactive maintenance

Qualifications for medical equipment technician
