- Completes appropriate client records in a timely manner as mandated by UBHC policy and according to accepted professional and evaluations standards

- Develops and applies knowledge of trends and advancements in the field
- Triage of patients referred to mental health services
- Complete scheduling of patients and documentation of clinical work in a timely and complete manner
- Assist patients with applications for pharmaceutical patient assistance programs, refill requests, obtaining and releasing medical records
