- Assists in preparation of utilization review monthly reports
- Provides assessments with empathy and concern for clients and arrives at accurate DSM IV-TR multi-axial diagnoses by the end of the evaluation session and updates when new information and clinical status warrant
- Provides clinical consultation and guidance to staff consistent with their needs
- Assists program supervisor to perform chart reviews
- Takes a lead role in the coordination and assessment of all intakes and referrals to assigned programs
- Acts as liaison with all referral sources, and community-based services
- Provides direct care community-based services that are consistent with the philosophy of UBHC and all regulatory and contract requirements

Qualifications for mental health clinician

- Licensure in a mental health discipline preferred
- Active Georgia LCSW, LPC, or LMFT license is required
- License in a mental health discipline (LSW, LCSW, LAC, LPC, LMFT or psychology license)
- Screener certification or eligibility for screener certification
