Responsibilities for middleware consultant

- Possess specific product-, technology- or industry-related specialized skills and works with proposals, requirements, designs, implementations and production projects/engagements
- Use tools to analyze and implement portions of a customer solution
- Provide technical advice to project managers/leaders and gives some technical direction to team members
- Interact with functional consultants and integration lead to ensure the successful fit of technical solutions against the business needs
- Work in client-facing roles to contribute towards the end-to-end delivery lifecycle of complex and technology solutions
- Participate in requirements elicitation, validation of architecture, creation and review of design
- Assign and review tasks for work product implementation with the objective of ensuring the highest levels of service offerings to customers in own technology domain
