Responsibilities for mill

- Verify the quality of products produced
- Verify adequate spare parts and consumables for proper milling efficiency
- Helps to establish and maintain the proper relationship with equipment vendors to improve responsiveness
- Track the performance of production equipment to maintain efficiency
- Schedule and track downtime hours with explanations for continuous improvement
- Help schedule maintenance
- Approval of production reporting
- Become proficient with measuring equipment and techniques (micrometers, calipers, protractors, measure tape, etc) and properly use these tools and techniques to correctly verify bar sizes and lengths prior to packaging into finished bundles
- Become proficient in using all other equipment and tools (crane rigging and operations
- Develop a general understanding and knowledge with all Finishing Area mill systems (roll lines, stops, chain and trolley systems, make up/storage/collection areas, tiers, carousel, stacker, strappers, etc) so as to recognize offset conditions and assist to implement corrective actions, changes or adjustments to maintain effective Finish Area operations
