Responsibilities for millwright mechanic

- Initiative or performance without supervision
- Maintaining industrial machinery and mechanical equipment and components
- Works from specifications and complex drawings, manuals, verbal/written instructions
- Maintains and continuously improves upon knowledge of all processes and equipment within their area of responsibility
- Performs maintenance on pumps (centrifugal and positive displacement), steam turbines, compressors (centrifugal and positive displacement), gearboxes (parallel shaft and right angle drive), hydraulic and pneumatic cylinders, process loading arms, fans and blowers and drive systems associated with the equipment
- Familiar with the basic shop tools such as drill presses, bench grinders, hydraulic presses and hand tools used to work on equipment
- Follows guidelines and procedures to ensure that equipment is working in a safe and reliable manner
- Participates in programs to ensure plant cleanliness
- Works with engineers and contractors to plan and implement installation of new equipment or systems
- Communicates directly with operations and warehouse to coordinate maintenance repair work
