- Pursue an active research agenda
- Direct culminating projects in graduate music education
- Develop supportive relationships with music educators in the Northwest region and beyond
- Carry out additional faculty responsibilities in the Department, College, and University as assigned by the Department Chair
- Provide academic and artistic leadership of a vibrant and multifaceted department – overseeing policy, personnel, and budgetary matters
- Sustain and advance program through active student recruitment and faculty development

Qualifications for music professor

- Three letters of recommendation sent directly to the search committee by email to musiced@bu.edu, and
- A list of at least three other referees who can be contacted for further

- Ability to work effectively and collaborate within the Fred Fox School of Music with outside groups, including related schools in the College of Fine Arts and community arts organizations
- Substantial experience teaching K-12 public school instrumental music
- Experience teaching college-level courses in instrumental music methods for preservice teachers, and graduate courses in music education with a focus on research design and curriculum development
- Demonstrate publications in the area of educational research
