



Example of Music Teacher Job Description

Responsibilities for music teacher

- Develops daily lesson plans and completes all required educational paperwork Participate as an educational team member in coordination with the clients, staff, and school and represents the program in professional meetings, family meetings, educational conferences, and teacher training workshops
- Become an active member in the school community by attending conferences, collaborating and participating in District programs
- Participate in professional development opportunities, professional learning communities, grade level meetings, subject level meetings, and school wide committees
- Communicate with all shareholders (students, parents, teachers, administrators, district personnel) regarding student achievement, course syllabus and scope and sequence (pacing), policies, classroom activities and opportunities, and current progress of the programs via meetings, letters, and submission of articles to school newsletters and additional publications
- Emphasize the creation of a positive, joyful school community and culture
- Remain available to students and families in the evening (via school cell phone)
- Hold at least two concerts per academic year and will perform at special school events
- Implement a steel drums curriculum that is aligned with high expectations
- Attend and participate in all school performances

Qualifications for music teacher

- Board certification in music therapy (MT-BC)
- Prefer successful 3 - 5 years' experience in an urban, multicultural educational setting
- Possess at least a bachelors degree
- Possess a degree OR significant experience in music education
- Must either possess a CA or out-of-state teaching credential or be enrolled in a credentialing program
- At least 2 years of full-time relevant subject teaching experience in an urban, underserved community
