Responsibilities for NDT inspector

- Provide complete and accurate electronic inspection reports to appropriate work cell
- Maintain NDT equipment and work cell in clean, organized and operational condition
- Continuous improvement to meet shop and industry changing requirements
- Work weekend and nights when required to meet client and shop requirements
- Interpret the results of all methods of non-destructive testing (NDT) such as liquid penetrant, magnetic particle and visual inspection / testing
- Visually examine materials, structures, or components using for signs of corrosion, metal fatigue, cracks, or other flaws
- Evaluate material properties using specified techniques
- Be capable of interpreting and completing the process controls required for penetrant inspection, proper lighting, temperatures, system performance evaluations
- Be capable of developing inspection techniques as derived from processing procedures, codes, specifications
