Responsibilities for network controller

- Follow Service Desk procedures for assigning and tracking tickets
- Examine ticket audit trail
- Monitor and report the condition of ticket queues as identified by management for tickets which could fail service level agreements (SLA)
- Good Mathematical skills, Problem solving skills and the ability to communicate with a number of stakeholders
- May be required to troubleshoot issues utilizing established procedures
- This is a rotating shift position and must be available for a rotating shift
- Conduct network outage monitoring on Tier 0, 1, 2 networks and alert parties responsible for troubleshooting, gathering updates, and producing reports for situational awareness of network status
- Conduct bandwidth utilization, packet loss, link connectivity and STIG analysis when requested by military personnel
- Provide recommendations for Quality-of- Service (QoS) and load balancing
- Ensure financial success for the hospital according to the budget including cash collections, net revenue and total expenses per day goals

Qualifications for network controller

- Issue appropriate notifications to other internal groups customers
- Capability to work autonomously self-starter and self-motivated
- 3 or more years of CANoe /Vector tool /CAN bus signal/message

- Experience or background in the development of vehicle electronic architectures
