Responsibilities for network planning

- Troubleshooting packet loss and latency on production circuits
- Working with customers to ensure efficient and accurate deployment of their Layer 1 connectivity to Softlayer's network for their Direct Link circuits
- Develop and monitor Supply Chain optimization guidelines for key technologies
- Partnering with the Global Strategy team to identify key capacity and flexibility conditions which must hold true for key supply chains to deliver the expected volume growth
- Partnering with the Global Procurement team to solve identified global constraints of raw materials and/or packaging components
- Escalation point for supply constraints that impact multiple Regions
- Driving and planning the development of the Mobile PS Core Network which includes SGSN/MME, GGSN/SAEGW, PCEF and Wifi Core in a hybrid environment (native with virtualization)
- Planning, developing and executing project work plans for network expansion and upgrades and revising as appropriate to meet changing needs and requirements
- Identifying resources needed and assigning individual responsibilities
- Managing day-to-day operational aspects of a project & scope including manages project budget, conducts periodic project reviews, monitors receivables
