Responsibilities for network security engineer

- Supporting Security Event Management (SEM) tools
- Escalation point for SEM related issues
- Manage and resolve incident, problem and change tickets
- Ability to analyze system logs, events and monitoring alerts
- Identifying & investigating repeated issues and work with Network and responsible support group
- Basic administration & troubleshooting of operating systems, custom applications and tools
- Review reports, files, logs, and messages produced by engineers, system administrators, and systems identifying instances of potential information security infractions
- Respond to trouble ticket calls and requests for service
- Provide onsite technical support as necessary
- Work with NMSIII Senior engineers on the deployment, administration, and troubleshooting of numerous security technologies

Qualifications for network security engineer
