Responsibilities for nurse anesthetist

- Participate in a team approach to ensure appropriate patient assessments, anticipate patient care needs, prevent avoidable complications, and achieve optimal patient conditions
- Administer anesthesia to patients under direct monitoring by anesthesiologists
- Review medical history, evaluate patients, and determine proper methods of anesthesia under the direction of anesthesiologist
- Assess the condition of a patient and discussion about the whole treatment and procedure
- Prepare patients for the entire procedure, included IV placement and other monitoring devices
- Assist with preparing patient for induction and emergency procedures
- Select, order, and administer medications under direction of anesthesiologist
- Perform or evaluate the results of diagnostic tests
- Prepare preoperative assessments including health histories and physical examinations
- Develop the Anesthesia Care Plan with the anesthesiologist

Qualifications for nurse anesthetist

- Bachelor of Science in Nursing or another appropriate baccalaureate degree from an approved nursing program

- Possession of a valid license as a Registered Nurse and APRN license issued by the State of Minnesota and successful completion of the certification examination administered by the AANA Council on Certification of Nurse Anesthetist
- Skilled in managerial duties
- NBCRNA certification
- Be a graduate of an accredited school of nurse anesthesia
