Responsibilities for nurse educator

- Assists and coordinates annual competencies
- Serves as a clinical resource for critical care and neuroscience
- Submits informational data to Director of Specialty Programs monthly and as needed, based on educational and quality improvement activities
- Coordinates annual competency sessions to ensure professional staff remain in compliance with safety, licensure, TB testing
- Involves other departments in planning and implementation
- Develops, implements and evaluates orientation and continuing education programs based on learning needs, clinical priorities, and organizational resources
- Participates in professional and community organizations
- Provide clinical support to transition patients from hospitals in Cleveland and Akron to the home
