Responsibilities for nurse, nurse manager

- Develops and maintains professional boundaries with staff, clients, and other collateral relationships and identifies issues as identified in the Code of Ethics

- Serves as the infection control officer for the facility which includes monitoring the infection control activities and reporting significant findings to the Medical Director

- Responsible for effective use of resources within budgetary limitations
