- Other clinical duties as assigned by the Chief of Surgery
- Coordinate referrals, scheduling and evaluation of veterans at the Marion VA Medical Center, outside VA's and private sector referrals of veterans to urology or orthopedics in Surgery Service
- Attend committee meetings and process action teams to represent the Surgery service at the direction of the Chief of Surgery service
