Responsibilities for nursing informatics

- Keeps current with healthcare trends, new technology & practices which are appropriate & support Lourdes' mission, values, vision & strategic goals
- Keeps current with regulatory changes & implements appropriate changes in electronic documentation to support regulatory changes
- Provide coaching, support, and subject matter expertise in Nursing Informatics to students enrolled in assigned course
- Communicate professionally, relate well, and share a passion for Informatics to motivate a diverse and large group of students
- Maintain current and active knowledge in Informatics in order to bring examples and ideas to students
- Leads initiatives to evaluate nursing technology in the NYU environment
- Oversees system design initiatives to enhance measurement of and compliance with key nursing indicators, core measures, regulatory requirements and metrics to determine outcomes and effectiveness of care and services
- Assesses and supports the implementation of processes for ongoing content management of best practice and evidence-based workflows and tools
- Serves as a liaison between the organizations clinical areas, including but not limited to nursing, MCIT, and related committees, ensuring coordination in training and implementation of clinical applications

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- Experience in hospital environment preferred
 - Five years of nursing experience in relevant clinical area with a minimum of three years clinical experience as a registered nurse in an academic medical center environment or comparable clinical experience preferred
 - Required - 3 years experience in a clinical practice setting including two years experience supporting automated Information systems and experience teaching / presenting one on one, in a group session or in front of a large audience (including providers)
 - An active, unencumbered registered nurse (RN) license (compact state preferred), and the ability to obtain RN licensure in additional states
 - An earned Master's degree in Nursing (MSN) from a regionally accredited institution is REQUIRED
 - A minimum of five (5) years clinical nursing experience, preferably in diverse care settings
