Responsibilities for nursing supervisor

- Reports any environmental safety hazards to QI, clinical manager, and administrator, as per facility practices
- Communicates nursing and physician activities as required per facility practices to clinical manager and administrator in a timely manner
- May be required to work the floor as needed to provide excellent customer care
- Makes systematic rounds
- Responds to emergencies and crisis situations effectively and completes reports accurately
- Closely supervises, monitors and evaluates staff performance
- Assists and intervenes as appropriate to ensure quality care is consistently provided according to policy and procedure and standards of practice
- Practices and directs unit staff in practicing universal precautions and adheres to facility policy with regard to spread of infections
- Actively participates in quality monitoring and makes recommendations to Director of Nursing recommendations to improve the operation of the nursing department
- Maintains department level competencies, supports education process for staff, and participates in performance improvement activities

Qualifications for nursing supervisor

- Current BLS CPR/AED certification
- Current licensure by the Maryland State Board of Nursing as a Registered Nurse
- Gerontology certificate preferred
- Current licensure as Registered Professional Nurse, issued by the PA State Board of Nursing is required
- Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) is required
