Responsibilities for nursing

- Remain proficient and fully capable of rendering nursing care in all functional areas of the Health Center
- Assessing patient needs through interviewing, recognizing, and interpreting symptoms and conditions in order to determine individual response to treatment programs and current medications and to gather and relay accurate reports to the healthcare provider about the patient's condition and/or progress
- Administration of medications as prescribed
- Understanding patients' health conditions and instructing them regarding self-care techniques and preventative strategies
- Formulating nursing diagnoses in order to outline a nursing care plan specific to the patient's needs to assure continuity of medical, physical, and emotional care during the treatment process
- Cardiac nurse navigator will oversees the clinical care of the adult and older outpatient population that are high risk for rehospitalization with a diagnosis of heart failure, atrial fibrillation and myocardial infarction patients
- The nurse navigator will coordinate care with the interdisciplinary team and continue to monitor patients while at home through telecommunications
- The navigator will collaborate with physicians to establish and maintain compliance with medication and treatment regimens for cardiac patients
- Identifies learning needs of heart failure patients
- Participates in care model developments within the nurse navigator team

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- Patient care experience in a healthcare setting preferred
 - Minimum of 5 years management level experience, coupled with a demonstrated skill-set in Labor & Delivery services management
 - Within one semester of initial appointment, must have a written academic plan of study for completion of a Master's degree in nursing, and
 - Provides ongoing documentation (each semester) demonstrating matriculation towards completion of a Master's degree in nursing, and
 - Continued employment of a person who does not hold a Master's degree in nursing shall be contingent upon documented progress towards their approved academic plan
 - Knowledge and understanding of simulated learning experiences, including the operation of simulators
