Responsibilities for occupational therapist

- Evaluates patient's functional status (muscle function, endurance, visual coordination, written and verbal communication skills, self-care ability, work capacity)
- Maintains and documents productivity standards set by the Director
- The Occupational Therapist is charged with completing an initial evaluation
- The OT must take into consideration past and current medical history
- The OT must possess strong communication skills
- Appraise the occupational therapy needs of students to design and implement appropriate remediation, instructional plans and strategies
- Analyze assessment results to drive and inform instruction and Individual Education Program development
