Responsibilities for occupational therapist

- The Occupational Therapist is a licensed professional who is responsible for maintaining standards of professional and ethical practice in accordance with regulatory agencies and the American Occupational Therapy Association (AOTA)
 - Provide care to
 - Works with the Therapy Services Director/Lead Therapist to ensure the supply of appropriate resources to support the programs, services, organizational structure and staffing levels necessary for quality rehabilitation services
 - Establish treatment goals and plan of care provide treatment to restore function, relieve pain, and prevent disability
 - Need to have proficient use of software systems for the maintenance of patient records and communication with team members
 - Plans, organizes, and conducts occupational therapy programs to help rehabilitate those impaired because of illness, injury or psychological or developmental problems
 - Tests and evaluates patients' physical and mental abilities and analyze medical data to determine realistic rehabilitation goals for patients
 - Selects activities that will help individuals learn work and life-management skills within limits of their mental and physical capabilities
 - Evaluates patients' progress and prepare reports that detail progress
 - Completes and maintains all necessary records and documentation thoroughly, accurately and promptly
