



Example of Occupational Therapy Job Description

Responsibilities for occupational therapy

- Reporting to the Manager of Therapy Services, this position is responsible for planning and implementing specific treatment programs for individual patients according to the principles and practices of occupational therapy
- The Occupational Therapist (OT) collaborates with the interdisciplinary team and provides supervision of the Certified Occupational Therapy Assistant (COTA) and the Occupational Therapy Aide (OT Aide)
- Provide therapy treatment to restore function, relieve pain, and prevent disability primarily to outpatient adult neurological and a few outpatient pediatric patients
- Designs the appropriate plan of care, including type and frequency of treatment
- Monitors and modifies the plan of care as needed
- Plans and/or assists with patient discharge from therapy services and provides information regarding appropriate selection/use of adaptive equipment and support programs
- Coordinates patient schedule with team members, readily and effectively adjusts schedule to meet changes in census, staffing, patient needs, space constraints
- Student advisement
- Maintains and monitors daily patient schedule, demonstrating initiative to confer with therapists for schedule changes and to make non-clinical prioritization judgments
- Independently demonstrates awareness of patient treatment needs

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- Must be a graduate of an accredited Occupational Therapy Assistant program
 - Must be able to use a smart phone
 - Must be able to learn an EMR
 - Clinical experience required, 3 to 5 years is preferred
 - Supervisory experience required, 3 to 5 years is preferred
