Responsibilities for occupational therapy

- Submits documentation required by the District
- Participate in the ongoing treatment of patients' functional status (muscle function, endurance, visual coordination, written and verbal communication skills, self-care ability, work capacity,) as delegated by the registered occupational therapist
- Participate in the ongoing treatment of the home environment for hazards or barriers to more independent living as delegated by the registered occupational therapist
- Attend monthly staff meetings or any other meetings or training as needed
- Provide services that are congruent with the policies of Southwest Home Health and within the scope of professional practice as defined within professional practice act
- Strive to provide services to meet both internal and external customers' expectations
- Assume individual responsibility for professional competence and clinical practice
- Assure that services provided are efficient and of value meeting the expectations of quality healthcare delivery within financial goals
- Monitors response to treatment plan
- Educates about deficits

Qualifications for occupational therapy

- Experience as an adjunct instructor and/or guest instructor within an occupational therapy program in the areas of physical disabilities, geriatric care and or mental health
- Experience supervising students in Level I and II fieldwork
- Master's degree in occupational therapy and evidence of completion of coursework towards a doctoral degree in occupational therapy or a related field
- Experience (full or part-time) teaching in an MOT program, with experience teaching a variety of courses across the OT curriculum including intervention courses (adult physical disabilities, geriatric care or mental health)
