



Example of Operating Room Assistant Job Description

Responsibilities for operating room assistant

- Searches for and recognizes "best practices" in customer service
- Performs direct patient care duties
- Complete duties associated with team affiliation
- Ensure availability of instruments and supplies needed for case
- Maintain, test patient care of equipment
- Serve on unit based committees as a representative of the Perioperative technician group
- Handle equipment and supplies, clean and decontaminate Operating Rooms and equipment, and operate and perform routine maintenance on a variety of technical equipment, and restock supplies
- Appropriately identify and safely transport patients to and from Surgical Services according to procedure
- Perform first case room wipedown daily prior to start of cases, decontamination between cases, and terminally clean the OR's at the end of the day
- Organize and restock storage areas within the Operating Room

Qualifications for operating room assistant

- Meets requirements of statutes, regulations and institutional policies relevant to RN First Assistants

- Meets all qualification of an RNFA as outlined in AORN Position Statement
- Must maintain CNOR and RN licensure with the required amount of Continuing Education
- Develops performance plans, identifies performance issues, manages performance and career development
