Responsibilities for operation technician

- Coordinate and record new circuit activations and deactivations including but not limited to operational parameters, testing, documentation and implementation
- Perform duties in adherence with Lyondell and Equistar procedures, standards, and specifications
- Must have high school diploma or GED equivalency
- Must be legally authorized to work in the United States on a permanent basis without visa sponsorship (U.S. citizen, U.S. Permanent Resident)
- Must be willing and able to work 12 hour rotating shifts and provide overtime coverage
- Must be willing and able to work occasional plant call-outs
- Must be willing to work with hazardous and/or flammable chemicals (with proper safety precautions, training, and equipment)
- Must be willing and able to stand and walk for extended periods of time
- Must be willing and able to work in environments that require frequent bending, reaching, and lifting
- Operate Test Equipment to ensure achieve Test Out target without create any Post-Test defect

Qualifications for operation technician

- Intermediate knowledge of server operating systems to include Microsoft

- High Risk License - Forklift and EWP
- Certification on certain area (CCNA, CCNP, Expert of system,) will be an advantage
- Required to work if workday fall during public holidays
- Physically fit to stand and/or walk for long hours and handle heavy loads
