Responsibilities for operation technician

- Ensure continuous efficient operation of production support system without disruption to production activity
- Perform analysis to achieve the reliability performance goals
- Establish programs and solutions for increasing uptime, and for issues that affect the manufacturing process
- Assist to perform risk assesment to analyse risks of potential facility-related issues and implement preventive actions to minimise the risks
- Follow all EHSS procedures to ensure compliance with the applicable regulations
- Champion plant specific safety initiatives through observations and team stewardship
- Monitor and document the process as required, making changes as needed under the direction of supervision and/or plant lead person
- Set up and maintain equipment through autonomous maintenance and plant continuous improvement (CI) initiatives
- Perform CIP (clean-in-place) and all other sanitation related activities as needed on equipment
- Complete all needed process documentation in a timely and accurate manner

Qualifications for operation technician

- Plans and schedules own work and others' work
- Optimizes plant process
- Fully starts-up, operates, stops, secures, and re-establishes steady state

- Documents maintenance history in CMMS
- Demonstrates understanding of plant efficiency goals and customer product demands
