Responsibilities for outpatient therapist

- Attends treatment team meetings

- Utilize skills in patient/client evaluation and treatment, professional consultations to achieve maximum patient/client independence in accordance with the individual functional level and potential
- Help patients accomplish treatment plan and accept therapeutic devices by administering manual exercises
- Instruct, encourage, and assist patients in performing physical activities, such as ambulatory functional activities, daily-living activities and in using assistive and supportive devices
- Help restore patient's function, alleviates pain, and prevents disabilities by planning and administering medically prescribed physical therapy
- Helping patients accomplish treatment plans and accepting therapeutic devices by administering manual exercises
- Instructing, encouraging, and assisting patients in performing physical activities, such as ambulatory functional activities, daily-living activities and in using assistive and supportive devices
