- Patient Care.Demonstrate knowledge of community resources and how to access them

- Actively identify and support linkages to community resources (communities

 mutual self- help groups, professional services,) that support the recovering
 person's goals and interests
- Support connections to community based, mutual self-help groups
- Develop relationships and partner with community groups and agencies to develop comprehensive wrap around services
- Visit community resources with recovering persons to assist them in becoming familiar with potential opportunities for long-term engagement, support, and encouragement
- Identify barriers (internal and external) to full participation in community resources and develop strategies to overcome those barriers
- Work with staff and other community stakeholders to implement and promote stopping stigma/promoting recovery through education & collaboration
- Assists families with understanding where they are in the enrollment process and how to renew their health coverage
- Answers help line as needed

- Must have reliable source of transportation to conduct outreach activities as required by the program
- Must have current Driver License as vehicle insurance
- A Senior Outreach Worker in this position will need the ability to assess patients for medical and social referrals
- Ability to communicate in both English and Spanish is an essential part of this
 job to ensure effective communication with all program participants
