Responsibilities for packaging technologist

- Execute and deliver on a range of packaging development & implementation projects that will lead to continuous improvement in product design and performance
- Leads project team during product/packaging development & implementation phases to ensure the packaging is compliant with all relevant food safety requirements, quality standards and shelf life requirements
- Responsible for ensuring the packaging databases for specifications and all packaging data are up to date and aligned with business requirements
