Responsibilities for park attendant

- Ensure water park area and capacity is managed per DOSH guidelines
- Ensure staffing levels are adequate for the day-to-day operation of the area, rotations and breaks are run effectively throughout the day
- Maintain minimum training as set down by the department's procedure
- Provide medical support from team appropriately for all guests
- Take pride in their wardrobe & appearance (Must bring a respiration mask to work daily)
- Water Park Slide Attendant is responsible for all aspects for Health, Safety, and Security within their area
- This position must be aware of the IIPP (Injury and Illness Prevention Program) and their obligation under it
- This position must follow all DOSH regulations for the Water Park
- The Slide Attendant must ensure that safe working practices are followed at all times and must notify management of any areas of concern
- Takes orders

Qualifications for park attendant

- Must have own ski/ride equipment
- Prior mountain operations experience preferred
- Minimum of 2 seasons of prior Terrain Park experience
- Must have experience using both hand and power tools which may include

- Must be able to work weekends, evenings, holidays and extended hours during peak times
- Must be comfortable working in a high alpine environment (working through inclement weather conditions)
