Responsibilities for park attendant

- Maintains a presence at all Races and Events and supports the events team as needed
- Set up, maintain, and break down the garden bar and dish area, including assembling/ disassembling the dish machine
- Stock/restock items on the garden bar according to specifications
- Assist guests who cannot easily access the garden bar by preparing a salad to the guest's specifications
- Maintain clean, stocked, and sanitary restrooms through regular restroom checks
- Rinse, wash, sort, and stack glassware, tableware, and cooking utensils/vessels by using both mechanical and manual cleaning methods
- Sweep up trash around exterior of restaurant
- Responsible for general maintenance of the garage – sweeping, wiping down surfaces and equipment, emptying trash, picking up trash, changing light bulbs
- Complete all required paperwork and reports accurately and efficiently to account for all collected parking revenues
- Develop relationships with merchants, vendors and complex occupants to facilitate their needs of the loading dock facility

- Have a current IAM StarGuard CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer certification or has the ability to obtain an IAM Starfish certification through

- Must be able to pass written and practical skills exam prior to duty
- Must be willing to work flexible hours, including evenings, weekends, and holidays to support park hours
- Full access control
- Handle product count discrepancies and if needed escalate to client management
